#### 1. (AI)<sup>1</sup> Call meeting to order.

(AD)<sup>2</sup>At 10:00 a.m., August 17, 2023 the Regular Meeting for the Board of Emergency Service Commissioners of Burnet County Emergency Services District No. 2 was called to order by President Richard Bremer at the Cassie Volunteer Fire Department, 3900 RR 690, Burnet, Texas 78611. Notice of this meeting (Enclosure 1) had been previously posted at the Burnet County Courthouse and the Cassie VFD website (<a href="www.cassievfd.com">www.cassievfd.com</a>), in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

  - (AD) Commissioner Bremer called for corrections to the July 12, 2023 Meeting Minutes; with no additional changes the Minutes were accepted as presented.

(AD) Commissioner Lee gave the ESD Treasurer's Report for July 2023.

Commissioner Bremer called for questions or comments for the Treasurer's Report; with no further questions, the report was accepted as presented.

#### 9. (AI) Discussion and/or action regarding the disbursement of funds

(AD) Commissioner Bremer asked for any anticipated items regarding upcoming expenses. Commissioner Lee reported nothing submitted for the month.

#### 10. (AI) Report from the Cassie Volunteer Fire Department.

(AD) A. Chief Curtis gave the report on CVFD activity for the month of July. CVFD responded to 19 calls –8 EMS/11 Fire/Other. Mutual Aid – 11 given, 0 received. There were 2 overlapping calls. Average response time for July was 9.42 minutes; In-District calls 4.76, M-F 2.89, Out-of-District is 10.02. Average personnel per call for July was 5.9 (Enclosure 3)

Chief Curtis reported that there has been an increase in Wildfire related calls and that CVFD did respond to two structure fires during July. Chief Curtis reported that one member had completed his Emergency Medical Responder Course at TEEX. There is also another potential member that has a lot of experience; his membership will be determined at an upcoming meeting.

B. Chief Curtis provided the CVFD Treasurers Report for July 2023. There was a balance of \$89,891.12 in checking. Expenses for July were \$11,502.33, which included routine operational expenses. (Enclosure 4).

Chief Curtis provided the CVFD Account Report—current balance is \$98,683.64. Chief Curtis stated that upcoming expenses will be for an evaporative cooler purchased by the FD. (Enclosure 5).

# 11. (AI) Review the Service Provider Contract for presentation to Cassie VFD for their review and signatures in September.

(AD) Commissioner Bremer called for questions and review of the Service Provider Contract that will be presented to CVFD at the September meeting. Commissioner Bremer discussed some items that are under review and may be changed. These items include:

Date change of CVFD Inventory to ESD Increase in Capital amount to \$2500. Attaching a Service Area map to the contract Changing verbiage to include community education.

Commissioner Barclay further asked questions related to the expectation for CVFD to exclusively fund Mutual Aid, SOP for members, documentation of members vehicle insurance, grant reimbursement and application, and development of performance evaluation, and education plan and goals for members. Commissioner Bremer stated he would discuss these questions with Mr. Campbell.

Commissioner Barclay also asked about setting a standard of Emergency Medical training in addition to Fire Training as the ESD has a far higher ratio of medical to fire. Chief Curtis stated that this was in the Department's goals.

#### 12. (AI) Report from the Joint Task Force concerning the 5-year plan.

(AD) Commissioner Bremer reported that there had been no meetings in July.

# 13 (AI) Update, discussion and/or action concerning the contract with Martinez Architects for the new Apparatus Bay building.

(AD) Commissioner Bremer presented the contract for approval with Martinez Architects and called for discussion. Commissioner Barclay asked that whenever Burnet County ESD #2 was used, as it was a legal contract that the legal name of Burnet County Emergency Services District No. 2 be replaced. There was no further discussion.

Commissioner Lee made a motion to accept the contract with Martinez Architects. Commissioner Call seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

# 14. (AI) Administrative update of the Sales Tax Program for ESD #2 including update on reports from Hdl.

(AD) Commissioner Barclay presented a summary of the Sales Tax income received from the HdL reports for July and August. In July, Sales Tax received was \$8779 which was a 39.5%

increase year-over-year. August was \$9518, which was a 13.4% increase year-over-year. She also reported that there had been no further information regarding the queries she had made. (Enclosure 6)

Chief Curtis reported anticipated income following the Solar Event and the potential for more venues in the area.

# 15. (AI) Discussion and/or action on the adoption of the BCESD 2 budget for FY 2023-2024.

(AD) Commissioner Lee presented the final budget calculations following the Tax Assessors report. The budget has been amended; there were no further changes. (Enclosure 7)

Commissioner Barclay moved to approve the FY2023-24 Budget of \$517,527.67. Commissioner Call seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

# 16. (AI) Discussion and/or action on setting the tax rate for 2024 at \$.10 per \$100 of valuation

(AD) Commissioner Bremer brought forth discussion regarding setting the Tax Rate for 2024. There was discussion related to the required verbiage of the motion. While the discussion that the actual tax rate is not being adjusted, the property values have increased, thus, this will increase the amount received. Amounts that were calculated were provided by the Tax Assessor.

Commissioner Barclay stated, "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of 10 cents on the \$100 of property valuation, which is effectively a 7.53 percent increase in the tax rate." Commissioner Lee seconded the motion.

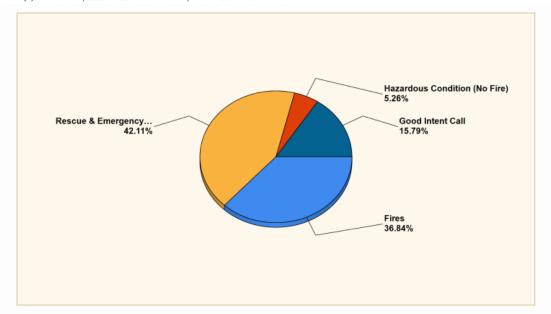

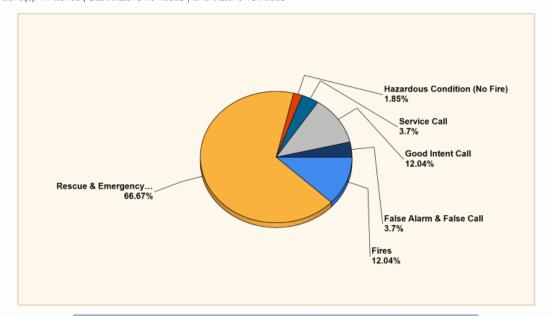

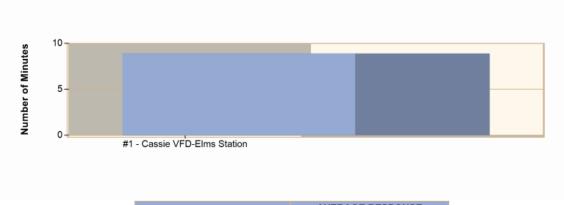

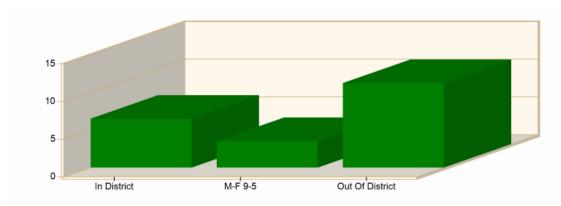

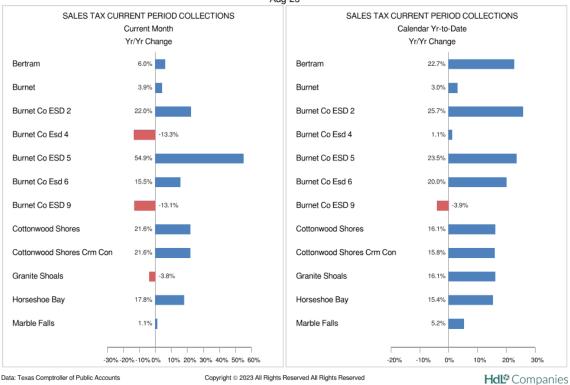

On the 17th day of August 2023, let it be known that the Board of Commissioners of Burnet County Emergency Services District No. 2 ("District") hereby adopted, by a majority vote of 4 in favor, 0 against, 1 absent the District's *ad valorem* tax rate for the 2023-2024 tax year of 10 cents per \$100.00 valuation of the appraised property within the boundaries of the District. Per the Texas Tax Code §26.05, the District has no debts and all tax raised by said rate will be used to fund the maintenance and operation expenditures of the District.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S RATE DUE TO INCREASED PROPERTY VALUATIONS WITHIN THE DISTRICT. BASED ON THE NO-NEW REVENUE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS RATE, THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 7.53 PERCENT. THE DISTRICT'S *AD VALOREM* TAX RATE FOR 2022-2023 WAS 10 CENTS PER \$100 AND THIS WILL REMAIN UNCHANGED.
